[TTS5U](#) GWO Working at Height & Rescue – WTG

For access to any area of a WTG where candidates may need to carry out installation, inspection or servicing on a variety of structures. Includes rescue. (2 days)

[TTS5UR](#) GWO Working at Height & Rescue Reval

Revalidation course for candidates who have a current RUK/GWO Work at Height & Rescue certificate (TTS5U), and wish to revalidate their training certification. (1 day)

[TSK7U](#) GWO Fire Awareness

Provides knowledge and skills to prevent fires and conduct initial and appropriate judgement when evaluating a fire. Covers evacuation of personnel, or if judged to be safe, to efficiently extinguish an initial fire by using basic hand held firefighting equipment. (0.5 day)

[TSK2UG](#) GWO First Aid

Covers the requirements of the GWO BST First Aid Standard including basic life saving techniques, using a defibrillator (AED) and casualty care training. Contains practical scenarios to assess, stabilise, monitor and then finally package a casualty. (2 days)

[TSK2UGR](#) GWO First Aid Reval

For candidates with a current RUK/GWO First Aid certificate needing to revalidate their certificate. Covers legislation regarding First Aid in the workplace, the skills required and role of the first aider including the use of available equipment and the recording of incidents and actions. (1 day)

[TSK5UG](#) GWO Manual Handling

Course provides training to encourage positive manual handling behaviour and perform manual handling activities in a safe manner within the wind turbine industry/environment. (0.5 day)
