

Screwlink pear 10mm

CSP10

Pear shaped connector used to attach rope device in a variety of rescue systems.

High strength.

Large opening of 22mm

Much more secure than a karabiner. Negates the possibility of cross loading.

The pear screwlink allows several connections to be made simultaneously.

It is most useful for rigging pulley systems where twin pulleys are not available and single pulleys must be attached side by side.

Screw barrel must be fully closed during use.
